



## **Scholastic Enterprise Edition & Next Generation Version 2.1.1 Release Notes**

### **Introduction**

This document outlines the changes in the Enterprise Edition and Next Generation version 2.1.1 release. ### **Important Note Regarding v2.1.1 Programs**

Version 2.1.1 updates must be installed over previous versions of the program's version 2.1 release.

All version 2.1.1 or later programs must be installed on servers using Scholastic Achievement Manager version 2.1.4 or later.

### **Updates**

The following issues have been addressed in version 2.1.1 for these products:

#### ***FASTT Math*® Enterprise Edition version 2.1.1**

- **Student Logout**

Students no longer receive a "You are already logged in" error message when attempting a second login of the day.

#### ***Scholastic Reading Counts!*® version 2.1.1**

- **Quiz Installation Browser Compatibility**

The Quiz Installer Progress Bar now works with all browsers.

- **Points Report**

The *Scholastic Reading Counts!* Points Report now functions correctly in all date ranges.

#### ***Scholastic Reading Inventory* version 2.1.1**

- **Student Login**

Students no longer receive a C42 error when logging in.



## **FASTT Math Next Generation version 2.1.1**

- **New Features**

The following features are implemented in version 2.1.1, completing the installation:

- **Style Gallery:** Students will be able to unlock styles from the Style Gallery.
- **Keyboard Navigation:** Students with accessibility issues will be able to navigate *FASTT Math* Next Generation by using the Tab key.
- **High Contrast Program Setting:** Teachers and administrators will be able to use the High Contrast Program Setting for visually impaired students.
- **Certificates:** Users will be able to create and customize certificates.
- **Demographic Report:** The report appears in version 2.1.1.
- **Spanish-Language Program Setting:** Teachers and administrators may set students' audio instructions to Spanish using the Spanish-Language Program Setting.

- **Domain Administrators Installation**

Users may now install *FASTT Math* Next Generation as a domain administrator.

- **Data Aggregation**

Data may now be correctly aggregated when *FASTT Math* Next Generation is installed but does not have any students enrolled.

- **Progress Report**

Data on the Progress Report now correctly displays partial weeks when that option is selected.

- **Student Dashboard**

The Total Fast Facts graph now correctly displays all weekly data.

- **Student Fact Fluency Status Report**

Report no longer shows incorrect data when the date range includes two initial assessments.

- **Student Login**

Students no longer see "There is a problem with *FASTT Math*" error message at login.

Students may now log in on days when a lesson has been completed in one operation and the operation is subsequently changed.



- **Student Program Settings**

The Fact Grid now appears correctly when the student's program settings are set to two lessons per day.

Students no longer see "You haven't completed today's work" message when attempting to exit a game after completing the day's required lesson and game.

- **Student Response to Intervention Report**

Report now displays Average Lesson Time correctly.

Report no longer generates an error message when the date range is customized with an end date that occurs before the initial assessment.

Report no long displays incorrect data after manually resetting the student's custom date range to include only the first assessment.

### ***ReadAbout*<sup>®</sup> version 2.1.1**

- **Student Software**

Version 2.1.1 improves the performance and stability of the *ReadAbout* student software.

- **Domain Administrators Installation**

Users may now install *ReadAbout* as a domain administrator.

### **Scholastic Achievement Manager (SAM) version 2.1.1**

- **SAM Connect License Manager**

Customers with License Manager enabled can now save license allocations and changes directly by clicking **Save**, rather than waiting for the next server check-in.

- **Banner Messaging**

Server updates and customer messages from Scholastic now appear on the Educator Access Screen as well as the Educator Dashboards.

- **Exports**

Teachers may now successfully complete exports using SAM version 2.1.1.



### **Scholastic Math Inventory version 2.1.1**

- **Intervention Grouping Report**

The Intervention Grouping Report now displays normative data for students in Grades 10–12.

- **Student Progress Report**

The Student Progress Report now displays normative data for students in Grades 10–12.

### **System 44<sup>®</sup> version 2.1.1**

- **Student Software Performance Report**

Functionality enhancements to the Student Software Performance Report are fully implemented in version 2.1.1.

- **Recordings**

Customers upgrading from 2.0.x versions of *System 44* may now play back recordings made prior to the upgrade to version 2.1.

### **READ 180<sup>®</sup> Enterprise Edition version 2.1.1**

- **Recordings**

Customers upgrading from 2.0.x versions of *READ 180* Enterprise Edition may now play back recordings made prior to the upgrade to version 2.1.

- **Word Window**

Students may now open a Word Window for words with accented characters when working in the Reading Passage in the Reading Zone and the Context Passage in the Success Zone.

- **Parent Report II**

Parent Report II now displays the correct reading level.

- **Spelling Challenge**

Holding down the Enter key in the Spelling Challenge no longer generates a 1009 error.



## **READ 180 Next Generation version 2.1.1**

- **Participation Report**

The Participation Report now displays median time per session and time per week for all students, and correctly displays median time per segment.

- **Reading Passage in the Reading Zone**

Dashes now display correctly in the Reading Passage. Words are now highlighted as they are read using Word Read-Thru in the Reading Passage.

- **Recordings**

Customers upgrading from 2.0.x versions of *READ 180* Next Generation may now play back recordings made prior to the upgrade to version 2.1.

- **Spelling Challenge**

Holding down the Enter key in the Spelling Challenge no longer generates a 1009 error.

- **Student Text Complexity Report**

The report dynamically aligns the student's grade level with the College and Career Ready Benchmarks and the Beginning of Year Proficiency (as defined by the Common Core State Standards) to present a more accurate graph and report of student progress.

The student reading-level column is now formatted; the report legend now contains dynamic messaging.

- **Word Window**

Students may now open a Word Window for words with accented characters when working in the Reading Passage in the Reading Zone and the Context Passage in the Success Zone.
