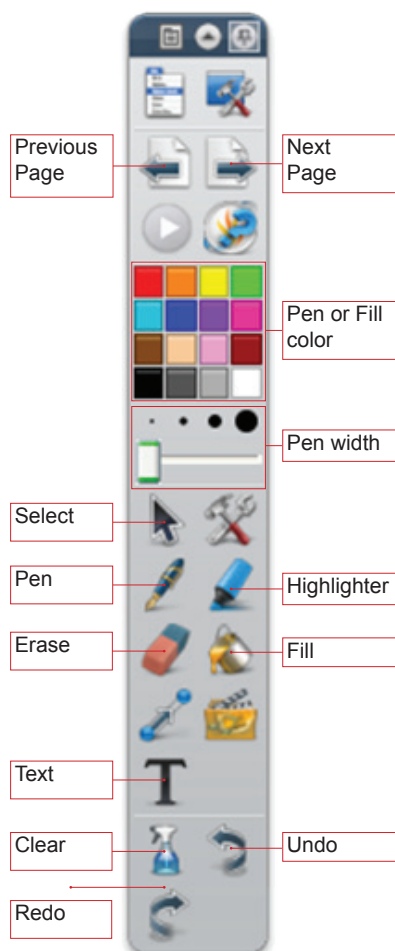
Using the Whiteboard Use the table of contents to go to specific sections of the lesson, or, tap **Next** to go to the first section of the lesson.

General ActivInspire Tips



The ActivInspire toolbar.

Some brands of interactive whiteboard provide their own toolbars. If you have more than one toolbar available, use the tools on the **ActivInspire** toolbar. Only these tools will fully integrate with the activity.

Select **Save As** from the **File** menu to save changes you have made to a flipchart file. Be sure to give the file a different name than the original so you will maintain a clean copy for future use.

Use the **Zoom** menu in the upper right to make the flipchart file best fit your screen. *Best Fit* or *100%* usually works best.

Objects dragged from a dispenser and marks made with the **Pen**, **Highlighter**, and **Fill** tools appear on the top layer of a screen. Tabs and buttons are on a lower layer, so they will appear behind dispenser objects and marks.

When you first install **ActivInspire**, the default tool is set to the **Pen**. If you wish, you can change the default tool from the **Pen** to **Select**. Select **Settings** from the **File** menu, and then choose **Tools** on the left. The choice of default tool will be the first item on the right.

If you tap a button to bring the **ActivInspire Ruler** or **Protractor** onto a screen, it will stay on the screen even if you tap the **Reset Page** button or move to another page. To remove the tool, drag it to the **Trash Can**.

If you tap the **Next Page** button on the ActivInspire toolbar while on the last page of a file, a new blank page will be created automatically. This is the standard behavior in ActivInspire and cannot be changed. You can remove the extra page by selecting **Delete** from the **Edit** menu.

The **Help** menu provides additional information about how to use the features in **ActivInspire**.
