

The *Foundational Teacher Training Portfolio* consists of five courses. Each course can be delivered in two ways:

- **1. One full day** in-person session
- 2. Three two-hour live webinars

COURSE 01

Fundamental Teacher Preparation and Planning

FULL-DAY COURSE

This course will provide teachers with strategies to more effectively and efficiently plan and prepare engaging learning experiences for their students. Through hands-on learning, participants will experience high-impact instructional strategies, focused on the Rigor/Relevance Framework, to support lesson development and delivery.

- Define rigor, relevance, and relationships
- Identify means of increasing rigor and relevance

2-HOUR SYNCHRONOUS LIVE WEBINARS

WEBINAR 1:

Elements of an Effective Lesson

This webinar breaks down an effective lesson plan into its component parts and provides a template of the essential elements of a lesson. Participants will gain an understanding of how to organize instruction to maximize student learning.

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

- Define aspects of the teacher's role
- Describe the elements of an effective lesson
- Recognize characteristics of engagement
- Use checks for understanding and formative assessment
- Identify effective scaffolding activities and instructional approaches

WEBINAR 2:

Rigor, Relevance, and Relationships

Participants will be introduced to the importance of rigor, relevance, and relationships in student learning. They will learn strategies to improve relationships, increase rigor, and add relevancy to their instruction to maximize student learning.

- Define rigor, relevance, and relationships
- Identify means of increasing rigor and relevance
- Recognize the importance of relationships in differentiation

WEBINAR 3: Routines, Procedures, and Strategies

This webinar provides participants with specific routines, procedures, and strategies to effectively prepare engaging learning experiences for their students.

- Identify practical means of grouping students for effective discourse
- Recognize the benefits of academic routines
- Identify the rigor and relevance of certain instructional strategies
- Differentiate learning tasks by process, content, resources, and product

COURSE 02

Classroom Management: Building Relationships

FULL-DAY COURSE

This course emphasizes that a well-managed classroom is one with strong teacher-student relationships. Strong relationships play a critical role in students' ability to complete rigorous work successfully. When students know that teachers, parents, and other students care about how well they do, they are more likely to commit to learning. Participants will gain an understanding that strong relationships complement and enhance rigor and relevance and will learn strategies to strengthen relationships, enhance engagement, and create an effective environment to improve student learning.



LEARNING OUTCOMES:

- Explore characteristics of effective classroom management
- Build consistent and effective routines into daily practice
- Identify the elements of an effective learning environment
- Explore mindset and learner engagement in establishing an effective learning environment
- Identify why building positive relationships is important
- Explore strategies for building positive relationships

2-HOUR SYNCHRONOUS LIVE WEBINARS

WEBINAR 1: Building Positive Relationships

Participants will understand that relationships are the foundation of rigorous and relevant instruction.
Through various strategies, participants will explore the value of developing strong student relationships and the impact that relationships have on student learning and classroom behaviors.

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

- Analyze teaching practices regarding management and relationship building
- Explore characteristics of effective classroom management
- Build consistent and effective routines into daily practice

WEBINAR 2: Strengthening Relationships for Rigorous Learning

This webinar will provide participants with strategies and routines to increase student-teacher and student-student relationships. Participants will explore ways to build routines, create student-centered activities, and develop growth mindsets to strengthen relationships in the classroom.

WEBINAR 3: Effective Environment for Positive Relationships

Participants will gain an understanding of how engagement affects student learning. Participants will explore classroom discussion and collaboration as strategies to increase engagement, build relationships, and create an environment for rigorous learning.

COURSE 03

Formative Assessment

FULL-DAY COURSE

Participants will learn how to use data to understand each learner's progress, adjust instruction, provide feedback, and document student progress. Participants will explore and engage with a variety of formative processes and tools that are easy to implement. Participants will analyze assessments and learn strategies to move assessments to a higher quadrant on the Rigor/Relevance Framework.



LEARNING OUTCOMES:

- Explain how and why teachers use data
- Identify the purpose of various types of formative assessment
- Develop formative assessments to assess specific skills and concepts
- Understand the attributes of various assessment types
- Design assessments to best determine students' levels of proficiency
- Identify scoring guides to describe different levels of student proficiency relative to assessments
- Identify characteristics of effective feedback

2-HOUR SYNCHRONOUS LIVE WEBINARS

WEBINAR 1: Leveraging Formative Assessments

This webinar introduces participants to the power of data from formative assessments to inform instruction. Participants will learn strategies for implementing a variety of easy-to-use formative assessments to understand each learner's progress, adjust instruction, provide feedback, and document student progress.

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

- Explain how and why teachers use data
- Identify the purpose of various types of formative assessment
- Develop formative assessments to assess specific skills and concepts

WEBINAR 2: Creating Effective Assessments

This webinar helps participants gain an understanding of different assessment types and factors to consider when designing assessments. Participants will analyze assessment items for rigor and practice designing their own effective assessments.

- Understand the attributes of various assessment types
- Design assessments to best determine students' level of proficiency

WEBINAR 3: Strategies for Scoring and Feedback

This webinar reviews the purpose of effective feedback and delivers multiple strategies to deliver effective feedback that will improve student learning. Participants will also gain an understanding of using scoring rubrics to assess student learning and communicate valuable feedback.

- Identify characteristics of effective feedback

COURSE 04

Differentiation: Instruction for ALL Learners

FULL-DAY COURSE

In this course, a focus on differentiated instruction will help teachers become better facilitators of learning for all students. In this hands-on, interactive course, participants will gain a greater depth of knowledge about differentiating instruction for the wide range of learners they teach on a daily basis. Topics will include differentiating by content, process, and product, and designing curriculum and lessons to manage a differentiated classroom.



LEARNING OUTCOMES:

- Acquire a working definition of differentiation
- Engage in discussions about why it is important for all teachers to differentiate
- Differentiate by content, process, product, and resource
- Gain tools to effectively manage the differentiated classroom
- Engage in strategies to support differentiated instruction

2-HOUR SYNCHRONOUS LIVE WEBINARS

WEBINAR 1: Laying the Foundation for Differentiation

Participants will define differentiation, recognize the purpose for differentiating instruction, and recognize the value differentiation has for all levels of learners.

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

- Explore the use of data to inform instruction
- Acquire a working definition of differentiation
- Engage in discussions about why it is important for all teachers to differentiate

WEBINAR 2: Effective Approach to Differentiation

This webinar provides participants with frameworks for differentiating instruction in a proactive approach to improve learning for all students. Participants will learn strategies to differentiate by content, process, resource, or product, thus maximizing the options for differentiating instruction.

WEBINAR 3: Strategies for Differentiation
