ENHANCING Comprehensible Input

The more meaningful the input, the more students can build upon it. Routinely provide opportunities to experience the target language in authentic contexts, including directed and self-selected reading.

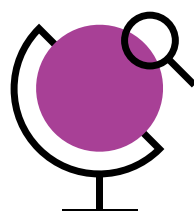


Self-selected reading in the target language is one of the most powerful ways to build biliteracy. Try using an interactive eBook with point-of-use support to inspire reading in the target language.

INTEGRATING Culture and Language

Immersing students in learning experiences that connect language and culture extends learning beyond your classroom walls while building intercultural understanding.

MAXIMIZING Retention

Retention studies conclude that the equation for retention = frequent exposure + relevance. When learners are compelled to engage with the language, their retention grows incrementally.



Engage students in authentic language activities that reinforce lesson topics and objectives while building on what is important to them. Encourage students to explore current events and media, to respond within protected social media spaces, and to engage with open source content.
