



System 44 students, Charles Armstrong School




From the beginning to end of the 2018-2019 school year, *System 44* students averaged a 60% increase in words correct per minute (wcpm) on the ORF test.

System 44 students, Charles Armstrong School




Increased use of the *System 44* software was a statistically significant predictor of *Phonics Inventory*<sup>®</sup> fluency score growth. See Figure 2.

Students could return with 70% of the learning gains relative to a typical school year.<sup>1</sup>


