

Latest Update to All Users from HMH Regarding Flash Usage and Support

HMH continues to update our Flash-based Intervention programs to HTML5 in response to Adobe's announcement that it will discontinue Flash by 2020.

The HTML5 version of the Interactive Teaching System (ITS) is scheduled to be available in Spring 2019. The HTML5 version of *iRead* will be available by Back to School 2019.

Student Achievement Manager (SAM), *System 44* Next Generation, *Phonics Inventory*, *Reading Counts!* and the Next Generation Dashboards have all been upgraded to HTML5 and are now available, joining the HTML5 versions of *READ 180* Universal, *Do The Math*, *English 3D*, *Reading Inventory*, *Math Inventory*, *Phonics Inventory*, *Reading Counts!*, and the Next Generation Dashboards.

Until updated applications are released, users may see notices in their browsers asking to allow access to Flash. They should accept these requests. The conversion to HTML5 should be transparent to users and require no additional steps for hosted customers. Local customers will need to download the updates (when available) from the Product Support website.
