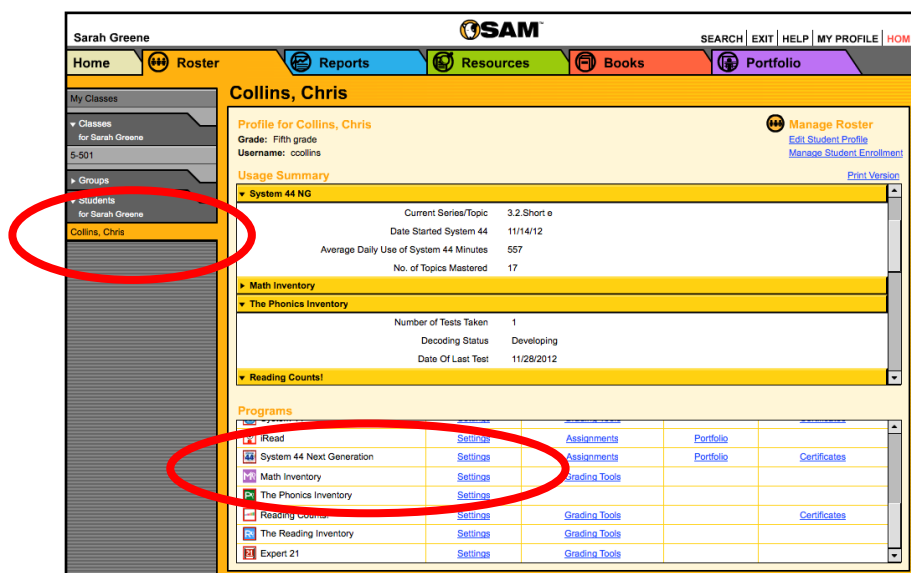


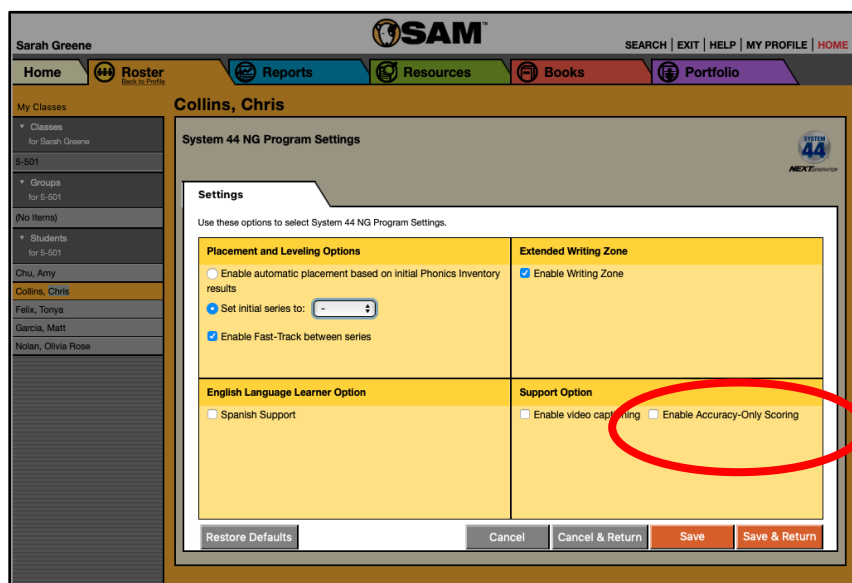
Using Accuracy-Only Scoring and Manual Placement in System 44 Next Generation

System 44 Next Generation now offers some new product controls, including accuracy-only scoring and advancing students forward in the software. Accuracy-only scoring removes the fluency threshold tied to timed activities and allows teachers to view data and score student work based only on accuracy. Teachers may also now manually place students within the program beyond the initial placement points

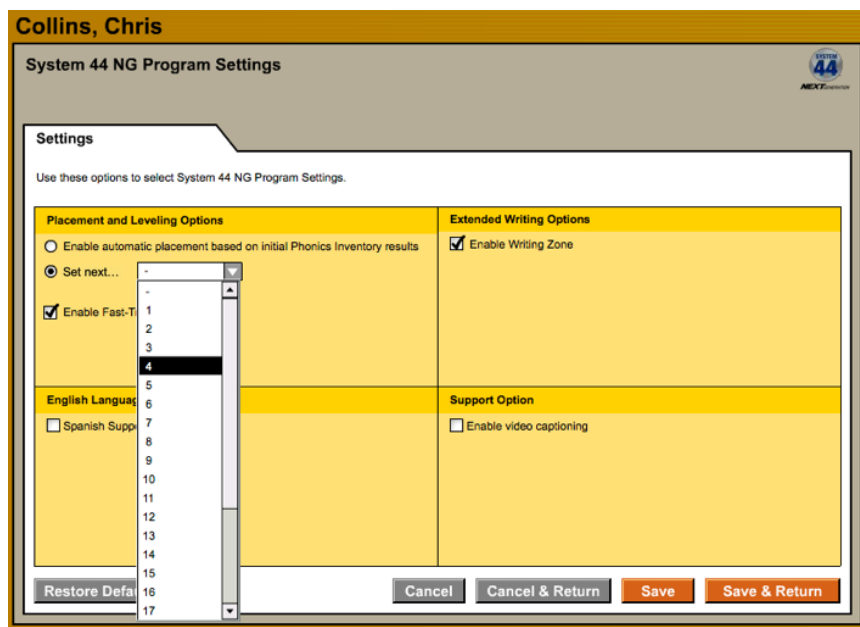
To select accuracy-only scoring for a student, select the student in the SmartBar, then click on the Settings link next to **System 44 Next Generation** in the Programs menu on the SAM Home Screen.



At the Program Settings screen, select **Enable Accuracy-Only Scoring**.



Teachers may also move the student forward to a new series using the Placement and Leveling Options under the *System 44* Next Generation Product Control Settings after they have started using the software.



Frequently Asked Questions

Once a student has started *System 44* and the teacher elects to move the student to another Series, when does that change effect?

That change takes effect the next time the student logs in. The student does not need to finish the current Series or Topic.

Can students be moved forward or backward in the program?

Students may be moved forward but not backward in the program.
